General Membership Meeting March 5, 2018

Kathy Bode President of Board 103 called the meeting to order at 0915 a.m.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Ms. Bode thanked the Committee for AM refreshments. The Weather Report was given.

All members table were welcomed (new, current and gold, and new members were reminded to stay after the meeting for a photo. Ms. Bode also welcomed Master Sergeant Kolak, today's speaker

Members were encouraged to sign up for activities and today's raffle. President Bode thanked everyone who donated to the Silent Auction as well as those volunteers who made it happen. The funds generated will help sustain the club during the more lean months.

The April speaker will be Deb Dickinson from the Family Visitors group

President Bode introduced Master Sergeant Kolak a 22-year member of the Cape Coral Police Department. Mr. Kolak discussed crime statistics in Cape Coral, which have remained stable for many years. Higher population has not changed the percentage. People are using more social media and technology to detect and report crime, which has been a big help to the PD. Car theft and burglary are the highest crime reported. He encouraged everyone to call in anything suspicious that they observe. There is an increased level of alcohol and illegal drug use. Traffic police have been reduced due to the governor's requirement of School resource officers in each school. Replacing those positions has taken longer then expected. Citizens may report reckless drivers by calling 911 or 5743223 for less emergent situations.

He encouraged everyone to take the Citizens Police Academy course or become a Volunteer Police Department member. This program saves taxpayers 1.4 million per year.

President Bode discussed the removal of the treasurer's report from the newsletter. Several members of the board have been targeted by internet phishers and scammers requesting monies. Finances will continue to be presented at the monthly meetings and anyone wishing to see the report should approach the treasurer.

We had a taste of comedy by RC Smith who will be performing at Anthony's on the Boulevard on 4/7 at 5:30 dinner and drinks will be included in this activity. The cost is \$28.00 per person.

The Board has approved some changes to the by laws. The change will require a vote by the general membership to occur before the start of the April general meeting. The changes are as follows:

Officers may serve 3 terms in any capacity with the exception of the president who may serve only 1 term.

Remove the 1 time open enrollment in September and allow potential members to join at any time.

Members may vote during their 3 year membership only.

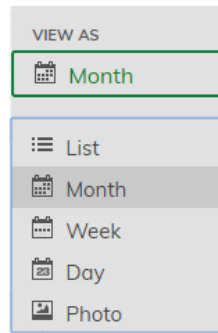

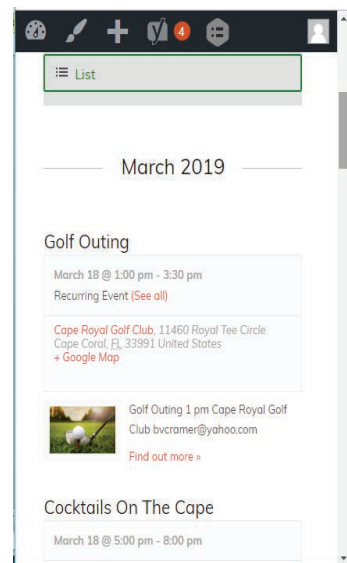

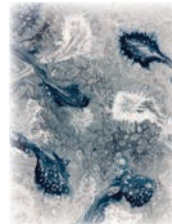
