General Membership Meeting June 4, 2019

Jeff Pollack, President of Board 104, called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance and was led by veteran, Allen Crawford.

Jeff thanked Board 104 for all their hard work in May, and thanked the NRC members for great attendance at the dance and activities.

Jeff thanked the Grumpy Old Gondoliers for all their work in the Cardboard Boat Regatta. He stated that there are also still some t-shirts that members haven't picked up.

Jeff welcomed the new members and asked that they go to the fountain after the meeting for pictures.

Jeff announced the raffles close at 9:30, and asked everyone to purchase raffle tickets. He reminded everyone that signup sheets for events are at the back of the room. There are two new clubs, Book Club #2 and the Photography Club.

Jeff provided updates to the newsletter: There will be a \$3 discount on the price of the dance in June. There will be a blood drive on June 19th, from 7:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. behind the Yacht Club – look for the big green bus.

Jeff will be sending out a survey to all members regarding a July BBQ on July 26th.

Secretary's Report: Traci Chepeus, presented the minutes. The minutes were accepted as presented.

Treasurer's Report: Rick Robison provided the financials.

Jeff welcomed the two guest speakers, Julie Ferguson and Charley Viera.

Jeff introduced the first speaker, Julie Ferguson, Director of Cape Coral Caring Center.

The Caring Center is an emergency food center. Their goal is to make individuals feel better, and to be treated with kindness and respect. They meet with each individual to learn about how the center can help them.

The center provides a 1-week supply of produce, meat, dairy, and other items to individuals. The center has helped 12,000 clients annually. They have supplied 1700 kid's bags, which feed a child for a week. The bags are given out in June, July, and August.

Julie discussed how poor diet can have a direct effect on poor behavior. Research suggests that the lack of zinc, vitamin B, and protein can cause behavior issues.

The center also helps with utilities, and has a Christmas store during the holiday.

Julie stated that there is a new Cape Coral United Way House, located by City Hall. The Caring Center will provide food to those in the house on Mondays and Thursdays. They are seeking volunteers to help with this new opportunity.

Julie provided an update on donations: A \$1 donation equals \$8 of value. With the snowbirds gone, the donations have gone down.

Julie mentioned that the Cape Coral Charity Car Show will be held on February 15, 2020, and all proceeds go to the Caring Center.

Jeff introduced the second speaker, Charley Viera, author of "My Father's War: Memories from Our Honored WWII Soldiers".

Charley moved from Massachusetts to Cape Coral a year ago.

His Dad was in Normandy, and Charley wanted to know more about the war and his experiences. His Dad's stories, along with other veteran's stories, are in Charley's book.

Charley stated that on average, we lose a WWII veteran every three minutes. It is important to meet with those veterans to hear their stories, and ensure they are not forgotten.

Charley mentioned that D-Day was supposed to be on June 5th, but weather impacted plans. On June 6th, 156,000 troops landed on Normandy Beach, and 24,000 airborne infantry parachuted in. There were 50,000 Germans waiting for them. Eisenhower had started planning the invasion in 1943. A fake invasion was planned, with a Ghost Army. Veterans had to keep this secret for 50 years.

Charley shared several stories from his book.

Activities: Daniela Fergen presented activities for the month, which included a boat cruise and painting session. See website for further details.

Ladies Luncheon: Colleen Carty gave details for the Ladies Luncheon at Ginger Bistro. See website for further details.

Dance: Kevin Marshall stated that the dance is June 22, with a black and white theme – come formal or casual. Tiger Blue is the entertainment and Papa Joe's is catering the meal.

1st VP Don Vuncannon stated that 21 new members joined today. And the newest NRC group picked the name, Pickled Pelicans.

Don Vuncannon introduced the new members. New members were reminded to meet out front for photos. And Jeff reminded members to tell others that the club is open to all residents of Cape Coral, not just "new" residents.

Jeff announced that Jim Farrell, from Wink, will be the speaker in July.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:12 a.m. and was followed by the raffles.




Does your calendar look like this on your phone?
