NRC FAQ

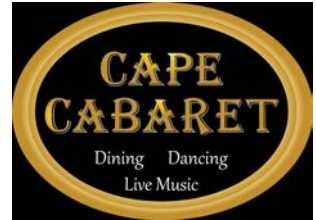
