Minutes from the December 7, 2021 NRC General Membership Meeting

She wanted to introduce us to their services of free tax preparation with some restrictions (businesses, etc.). 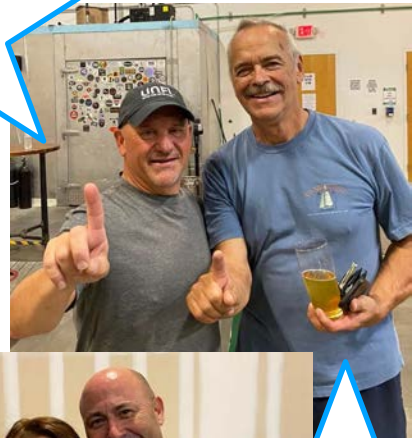
