# President's Message

#### I want to take a moment to thank everyone who attended the January dance at Palmetto Pine CC. I believe everyone had a great time at a great venue.

I have had lots of questions about the cost of the current dances and the open bar arrangement. I want to provide full transparency on the current pricing along with additional background information:

We had a long and successful run at The Yacht Club. When we were told we could no longer use that facility the board did an exhaustive search for a new venue. The decision was made to move our meetings, dances and other activities to The Lake Kennedy Center. While this was a smaller facility, it had a reasonable cost and afforded us the ability to use outside caterers, provide beer and wine and allow for BYOB. With Hurricane IAN FEMA occupied the Lake Kennedy Center and still does as of this writing. We as well as The Lake Kennedy Center do not know when FEMA will depart. This forced us to find a new location for the dances. We had previously made arrangements for the December dance to be held at Cape Cabaret. That was for one event only. For January through March Cape Cabaret would only commit to a Sunday or Tuesday night for a monthly dance. We were able to make arrangements with Palmetto Pine Country Club for the January, February and March dances. The downside is we pay a larger rental fee for the facility, must use their food service for catering (at a higher price than we normally pay) and their bar service. BYOB is not allowed. Our goal for all our activities is to break even. To do that at Palmetto CC we needed to charge a fee of \$55/person. Our options were to raise the price temporarily or cancel the dances for three months. The board decided the dances were an integral part of our culture and chose to move forward with them at the higher cost.

# If anyone knows of another event facility in Cape Coral that would provide the NRC the opportunity to continue with our previous prices and policies please reach out to the board.

We will again use the Cultural Park Theater for our general meeting on February 2nd. We hope to see you there. Mark Fleming, executive Director, has been very supportive of the NRC during the post lan recovery. I encourage you to visit their website and support them.

Our guest speakers will be Sandy Greiner, Marketing Manager Tropical Breeze Funpark and Scott Steele, Cape Coral Sail & Power Squadron.

Rumrunner's hull is a 1949 design by John Hacker. While the original plans were for a triple-cockpit runabout, the boat's design was modified by naval architect Charlie Jannace to that of a commuter. Rumrunner was built by Hugh Saint, Inc., Custom Boats in Cape Coral, Florida, for Will Stout.


